- Ø **Family Fun Day – October 15<sup>th</sup> – 4:00 until?** This will be a day for the whole family. It will include inflatable games, a cookout and a movie with popcorn on the patio. Be sure to invite your friends and neighbors to this special event.
- Ø **October 23, 24, 26, 27, and 30 – 5 Days - Judgment 18 – Dead Man Walking.** This ministry is one of our strongest evangelistic opportunities of the year. We need all hands on deck for this ministry. Please be sure to fill out a volunteer form this Sunday.
